The New Jersey Prescription Monitoring Program (NJMPMP) is a centralized data sharing system that tracks prescription sales of opioids and other controlled dangerous substances. The information contained in the database can help prescribers and pharmacists provide better care and identify signs that individuals are abusing or diverting prescription medications.
