<u>DUTIES</u>. Under the direction of a supervisory official, in a state department or agency, is responsible for the management of assigned federal and private grants within the department and the development of methods and means to secure new funds for proposed programs; does other related duties.

REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester-hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience.

Eight (8) years of professional accounting experience including two (2) years in the coordination of grant funding in a public or private organization and with automated cost accounting systems, including or supplemented by twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in accounting.

Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, including or supplemented by twenty-one (21) semester-hour credits in professional accounting courses; and four (4) years of the above-mentioned professional experience, with two (2) years of experience in the coordination of grant funding in a public or private organization including experience with automated cost accounting systems.

OR

Possession of a valid Certificate as a certified Public Accountant issued by the New Jersey Board of Certified Public Accountants; and four (4) years of the above-mentioned professional experience, with two (2) years of experience in the coordination of grant funding in a public or private organization including experience with automated cost accounting systems.

<u>LICENSE:</u> Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
