REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience as a cook involving the preparation of a variety of food in large quantities.

<u>NOTE</u>: Catering experience in a delicatessen will be acceptable.

<u>NOTE</u>: Deli counter experience in a delicatessen will NOT be acceptable.

NOTE: Cooking experience in a fast-food establishment will NOT be acceptable.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.

All offers of employment are conditional subject to the applicant agreeing to and then passing a background check that may include fingerprinting.
